You're riding your scooter home and a group of older kids block part of the path, teasing you as you approach.

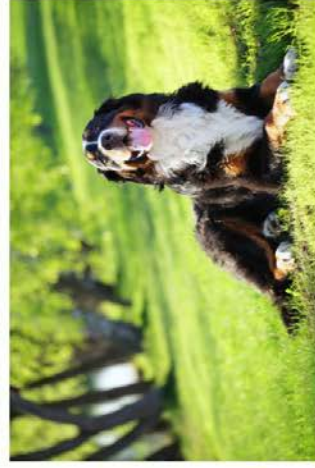
