## Road Smart Interactive – incursion (60-minute sessions)

Designed by road safety experts and education specialists, Road Smart Interactive is a highly immersive incursion program aimed at Years 9, 10, 11 and VCE Vocational Major (VM).

Facilitated by experienced road safety educators, students work through six interactive digital experiences – each exploring a different area of the Safe System approach to road safety. The program encourages students to think about how they can be part of the solution to making everyone safer on our roads.

## Road to Zero at Melbourne Museum – excursion (approximately 2 hours)



Embark on a captivating journey at the state-of-the-art Road to Zero complex, created by the Transport Accident Commission (TAC). This excursion, aimed at Years 9, 10, and VCE VM, offers a unique blend of interactive experiences and curriculum-linked education programs for Science and Health and PE.

Facilitated by knowledgeable road safety educators, excursions to Road to Zero comprise two parts:

- **Experience Space** (45 minutes) – An exploratory exhibition of 13 experiences.
- **Learning Studio** (75 minutes) – In the purpose-built learning hub, students undertake one of two curriculum-linked programs. For Health and PE excursions, students undertake the 'Getting the Message' activity where they create a public health campaign (video) about cycling or pedestrian safety. For Science excursions, students tackle the 'Road to Zero Physics Challenge' – a virtual reality experiment exploring the impacts of speed and friction on stopping distance, then apply their learning to a team-based challenge using touch table technology.



Teachers can download pre- and post-visit learning activities to enable class members to build knowledge before their excursion and expand their learning after the visit.

## Year 6 Safe Journeys Program – including Road to Zero excursion (3 hours)

The free Safe Journeys Program is a practical and engaging curriculum-linked Year 6 program that incorporates a visit to the Road to Zero Education Complex at Melbourne Museum.

The program supports students to become safe independent travellers as they near the exciting milestone of starting secondary school.

Created in collaboration with Year 6 teachers and the Victorian Government's Road Safety Partners, the Safe Journeys Program empowers students to develop trip planning skills – including the best route to and from secondary school – as well as safe road and public transport practices.

### Road to Zero excursion requirements

To participate in the excursion to Road to Zero, it is a prerequisite that your class complete Activities 1 to 3 in the Safe Journeys Program Teacher Guide. These activities are the foundation to a successful visit to Road to Zero and will be referenced in the experiences at Melbourne Museum.
