Public Transport If-Then-Because Responses

If someone needs a priority seat more than I do,

Then I will offer it and ask if they need any help,

Because it is respectful and a transport rule.

If I'm on a platform,

Then I will stand behind the yellow line,

Because it is a travel rule that keeps me safe.

If I'm listening to music on a train,

Then I will use headphones and keep the volume low,

Because it is respectful of others and I can stay aware.

If the tram doors are closing as I approach,

Then I will wait for the next tram,

Because forcing the doors is illegal and dangerous.

If my phone battery is low and I'm running late,

Then I will switch to low-power mode and tell someone my location,

Because staying contactable increases my safety.

If someone is standing too close to me and I feel uneasy,

Then I will move away and tell someone,

Because I have a right to feel safe and enforce boundaries.

If an argument starts near me on a bus,

Then I will move away or shift seats closer to the driver,

Because making space and being near a trusted adult reduces risk.

If train staff give me instructions,

Then I will follow their directions,

Because they're trained to keep people safe.
