Walking & Riding If-Then-Because Responses

If there is a pedestrian crossing nearby,

Then I will use it and encourage my friends to,

Because it follows the law and keeps me safer around traffic.

If the pedestrian light is red,

Then I will wait for the green signal

Because crossing on red is illegal and unsafe.

If I am riding my bike or scooter,

Then I will wear my helmet,

Because it's the law and protects my head.

If the lights are flashing at a train crossing,

Then I will wait and cross once the train passes,

Because crossing at that time is illegal and dangerous.

If it starts to get dark while I'm riding,

Then I will turn on my bike lights and message a trusted adult,

Because it keeps me visible and others know where I am.

If I am riding on a shared path,

Then I will keep to the left and ring my bell if passing,

Because it prevents collisions and is respectful of others .

If I am within 20 metres of a pedestrian crossing,

Then I will use the crossing and not jaywalk,

Because it's the law and reduces risk.

If I'm approaching a driveway,

Then I will stay alert and look out for reversing cars,

Because car drivers may not see me or stop.
