E-scooters in Victoria


We've expanded Victoria's e-scooter trial and now private e-scooters are legal under strict trial rules

e-scooter riders must

- Be aged 16 years and over
- Not exceed the maximum speed of 20 km/h
- Ride only on shared paths and roads that have a speed limit up to 60km/h
- Wear a helmet at all times
- Follow traffic rules
- Be visible at all times

e-scooter riders cannot

- Ride on the footpath
- Use a mobile phone while riding
- Ride while under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Carry passengers or animals or ride in tandem
- Ride a high-speed e-scooter one capable of more than 25km/h
- Ride on roads that have a speed limit over 60km/h





Penalties apply to riders who breach these rules
