

Summary of Photo Differences (Teacher reference)

1. Image Pair 1a and 1b: The bus stop

- The number of people (less in photo #2).
- The weather (raining with wet road and path in photo #2).
- The lighting (overcast and dull in photo #2).
- Safety markings/lines (present in photo #2).

2. Image Pair 2a and 2b: The train platform

- Position in relation to safety zone (ignoring the yellow safety zone line in photo #1).
- Proximity to the platform edge (very close in photo #1).
- The number of people looking at their phones (more in photo #2).
- Body positions in relation to the train tracks (more people facing away from the tracks in photo #2).

3. Image Pair 3a and 3b: Walking with friends

- Group member behaviours (one friend drops behind and is now isolated in photo #2).

4. Image Pair 4a and 4b: On the street

- The lighting (street is darker with sun beginning to set in photo #2).
- The time of day (shops are now closed in photo #2).
- Type of street (narrower footpath and path fencing in photo #2).

5. Image Pair 5a and 5b: Crossing the road

- Focus and attention (focus is on phone, not traffic and surroundings in photo #2).
- Location of crossing (pedestrian crossing is being used in photo #1).

6. Image Pair 6a and 6b: Riding public transport

- Headphones (listening to music in photo #2).
- Focus and attention (looking at mobile phone in photo #2).
- Position (standing up and holding hand-loop in photo #2).
